

Para-to-Teacher Tuition Support Program

Bureau of Exceptional Student Education



Program Description and Application Process

The Para-to-Teacher Tuition Support Program provides financial assistance for paraprofessionals who are currently working in Florida's public schools, to earn a bachelor's degree in special education. The program will provide up to \$700 per course for tuition support through annual funding from the Florida Department of Education, Bureau of Exceptional Student Education. Upon completion of the program the participant agrees to teach students with disabilities in a Florida public school for a minimum of two years for every academic year of tuition support received.

Admissions Criteria

In order to be accepted into the Para-to-Teacher Support Program, the applicant must meet all of the following criteria:

- > Currently employed as a paraprofessional in a Florida public school
- Earned at least an Associate of Arts degree with an overall 2.5 GPA
- > Be admitted to a state approved university or college special education program
- > Passed all portions of the General Knowledge Test

Applicants must submit a complete application, which includes all original documents to the state Para-to-Teacher Project Director. Email applications will be held until original documentation arrives.

Application Process

Applicants must submit all of the following items:

- 1. Para-to-Teacher Tuition Support Program Application form
- 2. Typed rationale explaining why you want to become an Exceptional Student Education teacher
- 3. Letter of recommendation from your school district administrator
- 4. School District Agreement signed by your administrator
- 5. Unofficial copy of transcript from community college, college, or university awarding AA degree or higher
- 6. Signed copy of the Service Obligation Agreement
